RCI's **SPCC** program helps facilities with bulk oil (motor and hydraulic) and fuel comply with the EPA's Clean Water Act originally enacted in 1974 and last revised in 2002.

Any business that has bulk oil with an aggregate aboveground storage capacity of 1,320 gallons of oil or more per location must have an **SPCC** Plan. Oil is considered to be crude oil, gasoline, diesel, waste oil, oil emulsions, lube oils, and grease. Synthetic oils are also included.

Finable SPCC violations include but are not limited to:

- Adequate records of drainage events are not maintained.
- No plan discussion of appropriate containment.
- Plant not certified by a professional engineer.
- Inadequate or no secondary containment.
- No record of inspections.
- No facility security.
- No SPCC Plan
